

Judging Guidelines For International Meets - Option I, II & Best of Show

Judging Guidelines for Regional Meets - Option II And Best of Show

- All entries must have current MOCNA membership.
- All entries must have an approved fire extinguisher.
Minimum requirement: 2½ lb. Dry chemical, or 5 lb. Carbon dioxide UL approved or equivalent.

Option I

400 Point Concours Judging Class

1. Open to original cars, or restored cars as close as possible to original. Entries may be limited at the discretion of the judges.
2. All cars will be judged in one class using the point system.
All entries receiving 375 Points to 400 Points will be awarded a gold grill badge.
All entries receiving 350 Points to 374 Points will be awarded a silver grill badge.
All entries receiving 325 Points to 349 Points will be awarded a bronzed grill badge.
Grill badges could be upgraded at future International Meets as the car is improved.
A class of gold winners could be added in the future as needed.
3. Qualified judges will be appointed by the MOCNA Chief Judge or President.
4. The decision of the Chief Judge is final.
5. Judging sheets will be mailed to each entrant 30 days after International Meet.
6. A cost of \$25.00 for each qualified car.

Option II

Popular Vote Class

1. 7 class ballot will be issued to each adult entered on registration form.
2. Three trophies awarded in each class.
3. Judges reserve the right to combine classes if less than three cars represented.

1. Open to all cars, Concours or Popular.
2. Ballots will be issued to each adult on registration form.
3. The William Flajole Memorial award will be presented to the Best of Show winner at all International Meets.
